Where to Find Your Vehicle Identification Number (VIN)

For 1966-77 Broncos the VIN plate is attached to the rear face of the driver's door or on the glove box door. The information on the rating is the VIN number. The VIN number identifies the Series, Engine, Assembly Plant, Model Year and Production Sequence.
