4L60/TH700R4, 4L60E and 4L80E Transmissions can be identified by the absence of the Modulator and by the shape of the transmission pan.


- 4L60/TH700R4, 4L60E and 4L80E - Have no modulator.

All Transfer Cases have an assembly tag attached to their case. The tag may be a bolted, riveted or screwed on metal tag, or a stick-on paper tag. The Transfer Case must be identified by the assembly number listed on the tag. If your tag number does not appear on the line, it will not fit your truck. See illustration.
